

# *The Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students.*

WILLIAM COLENZO COLLEGE is a signatory to this document. It has been developed by the New Zealand Ministry of Education to ensure that students coming to New Zealand to study from overseas are well cared for and that schools provide suitable education programs for them.

In summary the Code sets standards for educational providers (such as William Colenso College) to ensure that:

1. High professional standards are maintained
2. The recruitment of international students is undertaken in an ethical and responsible manner
3. Information supplied to international students is comprehensive, accurate and up-to-date
4. Students are provided with information prior to entering into any commitments
5. Contractual dealings with international students are conducted in an ethical and responsible manner
6. The particular needs of international students are recognized
7. All providers have fair and equitable internal procedures for the resolution of international student grievances
