



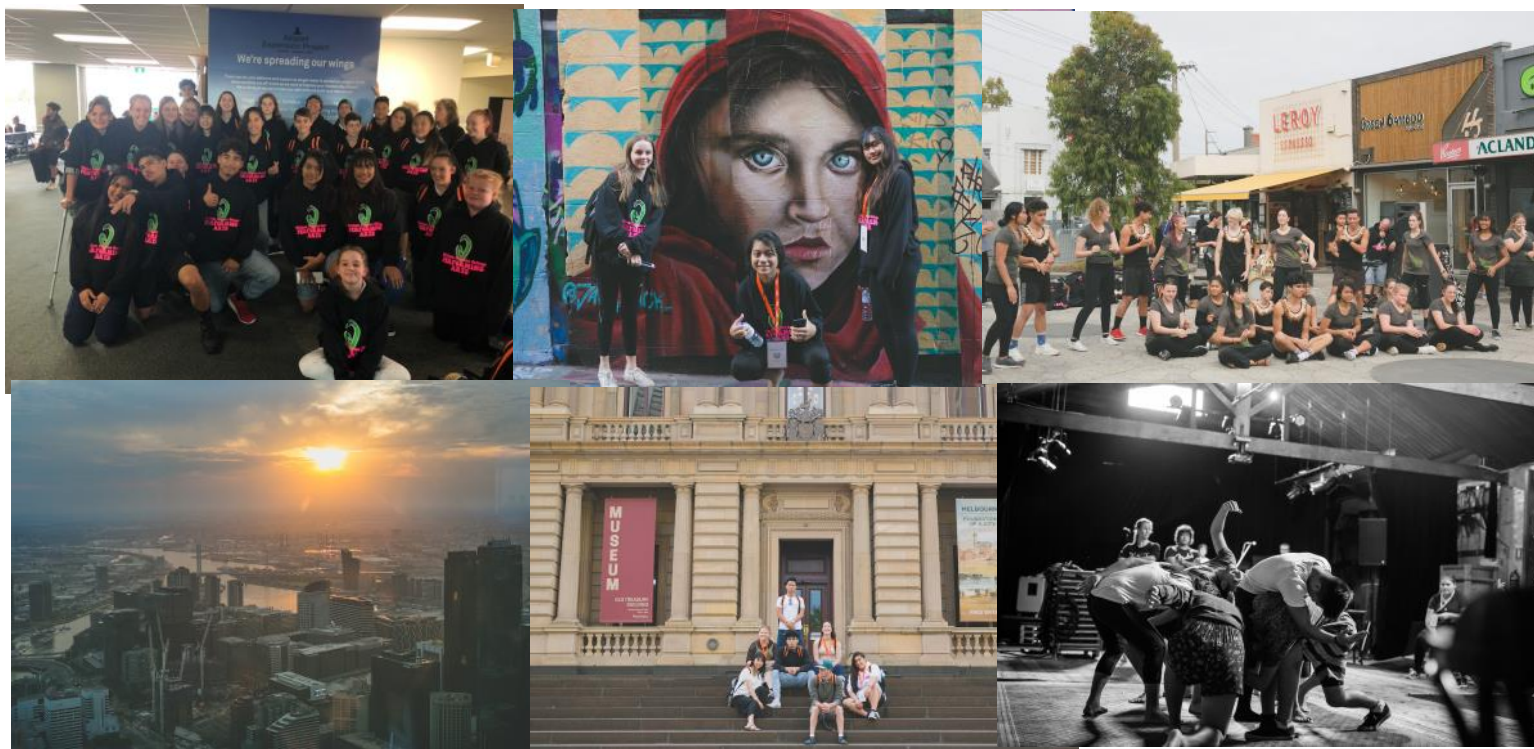
## Term 2: 29th April - 10th May 2019
